

Which service meets my needs?

HOME HEALTH

Patient has:

Therapy needs

(e.g., rehabilitative therapy, post-surgical management, fall prevention, post-surgery rehab)

• Skilled needs

(e.g., skilled nursing, medication management, disease management, home IV therapy, wound care management, or LVAD, TPN, PleurX catheter)

- Primary care doctor willing to follow
- Physician referral to obtain covered care

Home health is:

- Provided alongside ongoing palliative care services (if the patient has them)
- Considered life-sustaining
- Covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance companies

PALLIATIVE CARE

Patient is:

- · Diagnosed with any advanced illness
- Undergoing curative treatment/therapies
 Wanting to discuss goals of gave (advance)
- Wanting to discuss goals of care/advance directives
- Interested in staying active and comfortable
- Desiring added support to cope with advanced illness

Palliative care:

- Can include managing the symptoms of chronic advanced illness (e.g., pain, shortness of breath, anxiety/ depression, lack of appetite)
- Is considered life-sustaining
- Is covered by Medicare Part B, Medicaid, and most private insurance companies

Patient is:

HOSPICE

- · Diagnosed with a life-limiting illness
- No longer undergoing curative treatment/therapies
- Desiring 24/7 access to care team

Hospice is:

- A philosophy of care providing medical, emotional, and spiritual support
- Provided by an interdisciplinary team (doctor, nurse, spiritual care counselor, social worker, nurse aide, and/or trained volunteer)
- Focused on quality of life and symptom management, not curative treatment
- Covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance companies and managed care partners

We serve every eligible patient, regardless of their ability to pay.

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
